PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia Ora Koutou Whānau o Mangorei!

Our caretaking team breathe a sigh of relief when the cold southerly whips through and helps clean out the leaves from our twin trees out the front of the school. This signals the movement towards the end of one season and into the next, Summer now a definite distant memory captured on ones phone. In my mind Autumn goes down as the most beautiful of the seasons.

Next Friday is a Teacher Only Day here at Mangorei. This is the first of two Ministry provided days where we as a staff get an opportunity to process changes upcoming in the Curriculum Refresh. There is no doubting that this process has been slowed by the change of government and then a change in focus which has meant there is still a big amount of 'wait and see' happening in the space for schools.

One thing we have been told, is the 'Understand, Know, Do' model (which is how the earlier developed 'refreshed' curriculums of Social Sciences and Aotearoa NZ Histories are structured) will follow through in the other refreshed curriculum areas. These are three elements that teachers weave through into learning experiences so that student learning is meaningful and has depth. This resonates strongly with us as a staff and is part of our planning of learning units in the school.

The school, for the next few weeks, is alive with scooters and bikes as we aim to improve the ability of our tamariki to bike and scooter for fun and with safety. This ties in with our target of lifting the amount of tamariki that use walking, biking and scootering as options for active transport, to and from school. In collecting some data last year we had 23.2% of kids active travel to school on a beautiful sunny day. Watch this space for more initiatives to help us promote our stunning new footpath and get more feet and wheels on it!

Finally we as a staff have been affected greatly by the sad news of the passing of one of our ex-pupils whilst they were studying at university. The funeral will be happening in the week coming and will not affect the running of the school and classes.
