PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Ahiahi Mārie Mangorei Whānau,

As a staff we very much appreciated the time in having the Teacher Only Day on Friday. We were able to work alongside Ministry of Education Advisor Brigitte Luke as she furthered us along the journey around the Curriculum Refresh. Some key information we got was around the changing timeframe for the implementation of different curriculum areas. I've included the graphic below.



We were also told that these timeframes are under revision by the government at present but you can see we are still in the 'explore and use' phase for all areas, except for the Histories Curriculum which we must be using. Science, Technology and The Arts refreshed curriculums are due at the end of the term but no word yet on dates. We will update you if there are changes to the timeline. We like having the community aware of what curriculum changes we are experiencing here so you know that Teacher Only Days are like gold for us to be able to work through these changes - some parents told a teacher 'enjoy your day off' on Thursday - it certainly wasn't that!

As part of the day we also looked at the Science of Learning where we watched Nina Hood, educationalist, researcher and secondary trained teacher speak on memory, how students need time to encode new learning by building onto existing schema and then practice at retrieving it. This fits in strongly with the learning we have done with educationalist Lane Clark and is encouraging to know that all schools are looking at this research.

On a separate topic it was brilliant to have a positive group of supportive parents come to the AGM meeting for the PTA. I want to acknowledge the amazing work of *Rebecca Collier* who came into our PTA when her tamariki were so young to fill the Chairperson role 5 years ago. The PTA was in danger of no longer existing and Rebecca kept the home fires burning which saw some big wins for our tamariki, including a donation to the school board which saw the new Blue Playground built at school - 4 years later and we still have arguments over swings - that's how cool they are! We also had *Tracey Gregory* stand down as Treasurer. Tracey has also been in the role for 5 years and has done a stellar job of keeping her finger on the pulse of fundraising. This is a time consuming role and we have very much appreciated the effort put into this job for our school - personally I want to really say thank you to you both - the Covid journey posed all sorts of twists and turns yet you kept getting good wins for our students - Ka rawe kia kōrua! Special thanks to the new torchbearers *Andrea Matthews* and *Emma Hall* who have stepped into these roles - your enthusiasm and openness to learn and get involved is very much valued!

PUANGA DAY - FRIDAY 21st JUNE

As mentioned in our newsletter last week, our national Matariki celebration will be 28th June. However in Taranaki it is puanga (rigel) that we look for in the skies to help welcome in the the coming year. Therefore, our school will be celebrating puanga the week before Matariki by having a whole school Puanga Day.

This will involve all our students completing different activities throughout the day. To begin the day they will spend time with their classroom learning about puanga. After morning tea our tuakana/teina classes will work together to create whētu (stars) that will be displayed in the hall. The afternoon will be spent in our syndicates completing different traditional activities (weaving, games, art, waiata and so on).

Leading up to our Puanga Day our school whariki will go on tour around all the classes, for our akonga to take a closer look at and look after.

As part of this day we will also be holding a special puanga assembly at 12pm. We felt that this celebration was the perfect time of the term to have our **Whānau Kai Tahi**. Whānau are welcome to come and enjoy our assembly as well then spend time with your tamariki for lunch. Children will be expected to stay at school after whānau kai tahi, and take part in their syndicate activities in the afternoon.
