PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Ngā Mihi o te Rā, Greetings of the day,

We have been right into the busy-ness of the 7th week of term, with good things happening at Mangorei! Special thanks to Angela Duncan, Craig Henson, Morgan Brewer, Maree Smith, Kirsten van Greevenbroek and Rebecca **Connolly** who chose over these last few terms to continue their journey with Te Reo and spent the last two days in immersion of the language. Wonderful to have staff volunteering their time (they have met once every week for classes over the last two terms as well) to extend and develop themselves for the benefit of extending our tamariki. Over this year this has been on top of continued professional development in literacy as well.

It is good to re-introduce our School Chaplain, Alison Slater, to our community as well. Alison has been with Mangorei for over two years and is trained in her role. She has the pleasure of getting alongside students who may need a listening ear, someone to talk to and to know that she is a regular here at school (Alison is at school Wednesday afternoons and is looking at extending her time). Although a local Minister at Brooklands Church, her role here is non-religious and is purely a support and care role. At present, staff can identify tamariki who are going through tough times due to outside factors that are generally beyond their control and outside of school.

If you feel that your child could do with an opportunity to speak with Alison then make contact with their class teacher and this can be arranged. Alison builds relationships with tamariki in the class with the teacher and students and can take tamariki out for activities whilst opening the way for conversations to occur. At present Alison is working with groups on the Seasons for Growth programme which deals with tamariki going through grief, loss or change.



I look forward to seeing you all next week as our teachers organise a full day on Friday 21st June to acknowledge Puanga and the New Year that is nearly upon us! So exciting! You are welcome to come to an assembly we are having (we hope for good weather!) on the courts at **12pm** then stay on for Whanau Kai Tahi in the lunchtime. PTA will have sausages and drinks for sale, our Envirogroup tamariki will have vegetable soup and your children can take you through their rooms and the learning they have been doing in class. Look forward to seeing you next week!
