PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Kia Ora Koutou Mangorei Whānau,

I want to acknowledge the passing of one of the great leaders of our generation of Te Arikinui Kiingi Tuheitia. He has been credited by our Prime Minister *Chris Luxon* as bringing Māori together with a focus on unity and kotahitanga. Tuheitia was a very humble leader and it was through this that he held his influence, not just with Māori but with the leaders of our nation. Tuheitia had been Māori King for 18 years and will be remembered for his legacy of work around working towards greater equity for Māori and building a stronger treaty partnership. Our school flag has been flown at half mast over this week and our school staff will wear black on Thursday which will be the day of his burial. We don't have the expectation for our tamariki to do this also.

The Draft English Curriculum has arrived at schools and so, together with the Draft Maths Curriculum from a few weeks ago there has been some hefty reading done in a short time. We are able to provide feedback in a very short window of four weeks and so our three roopu (Te Tihi o Taranaki Y0-3, Ahuwhenua Y4-6, and Te Tai o Rēhua Y7-8) are giving their professional feedback to the Ministry of Education this week. On the surface it is good to have greater clarity around the sequence of learning that ākonga have at each phase of learning, as well as have these grounded in the science of learning - the greatest hindrance is the timeframe and the big pressure point put on educators with two crucial curriculum areas (totalling 210 pages) in the space of weeks, and then implement into planning for teaching the new Maths Curriculum and English (Years 0-6) from start of 2025.

I want to acknowledge the wonderful work of our PTA - I'm not certain the value of this group is really fully known throughout the school! This group builds a parent team through working together. It fundraises for the school for sure, but while doing so it helps to bring together our community members. This last week alone *Natalie McLeod* and *Angela Kirby*, with others, coordinated the set up of the phone book deliveries, patiently waiting for the pallet of books to arrive and unload, and then sort the system for us as a community to do the drops. *Linda Armstrong* and her team sorted pizza money, and then did the deliveries around the school the other week and are gearing up for another. *Rachel Deegan* coordinated another successful High Tea at Tūpare with great community support in behind this - thank you all so much!

Finally I want to say a big thank you to the staff - I was away with my family who had come together due to a family tragedy. Our staff have been a wonderful support, and in turn continued the wonderful work in school. We have a strong and experienced leadership team at school and an excellent office team. A big thanks to *Emma Saywell* who coordinated the complexities of the week with me away. Ka rawe kia koe, and ka rawe kia koutou to the Mangorei staff - much appreciated.

This included coordinating the Endurance and Resilience Run on Friday with the most changeable of days. Thank you for rolling with the changes while the staff made timetable adjustments etc. To **Anne Stuck** and the Te Tihi o Taranaki Roopu a big thanks for organising the day and getting the kids through it. I know they are looking to do the obstacle course on a fine day to continue promote fun through movement with the school.

A REMINDER ABOUT BEING SAFE AT 3PM

At 3pm when the bell goes can we please ask our community to do some important actions to ensure the safety of our tamariki and other footpath and road users.

******IMPORTANT UPCOMING ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION******

SH3 UPCOMING LANE CLOSURES | NZ Transport Agency Waka Kotahi have announced upcoming lane closures at SH3 Burgess Park (between Mangorei and Kent Roads) for 8 weeks from 16 September 2024.

During this time, SH3 between Mangorei and Kent Roads will be under a 24/7 single lane closure to southbound traffic from midnight to midday, and to northbound traffic from midday to midnight every day for the duration of works.



****IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR OUR BUS STUDENTS DURING THE ROAD CLOSURE****

Our students who travel to and from school on the bus will go via the normal route into Mangorei School in the morning. We would suggest the departure time from the Hall in the morning, be brought forward by 10 minutes during these works to ensure we meet the transfer with Withers at your school on time. The morning departure time during these works will be 7.50am. The afternoon bus will collect the students from Mangorei School as normal, travel out to Mangorei Hall as normal, the traffic will determine if we arrive at the hall slightly later or not.
