

AIMS GAMES

Well done and congratulations to our Year 8 student Olivia Roche who had an amazing time at the AIMS Games in Tauranga this week and did fantastic! She came home with two ribbons that were awarded to the 4-10th placed finalists.

Olivia's results are as follows:

- Girls 13yr old 50m freestyle placed 24/52 with a time of 30.84
- Girls 13yr old 50m backstroke placed 8/50 with a time of 33.77
- Girls 13yr old 100m freestyle placed 27/55 with a time of 1:09.59
- Girls 13yr old 200m backstroke placed 10/27 with a time of 2:43.00
- Girls 13yr old 200m freestyle placed 12/33 with a time of 2:29.25

Just to give just you an idea of how big the event was, here are some facts:

> There were 24,000 visitors to the region 14,021 Competitors Aged 11-13 431 Schools; 4 International Schools 489 Swimmers on the first day of racing!

All swimmers had to meet tough qualifying times and there were some very talented young swimmers. Olivia has also met the qualifying times for Division 2 next year for her 50m back and 200m back. She is training to compete in more races next year in Dunedin.


